Unfortunately for Stephanie the crate holding the puzzles is lying on the southeast side of her garden plot, and she needs to load it into her van parking on opposite side of the garden to the northwest. She needs to navigate the crate through her garden without breaking any of the cold frames protecting her new plantings.

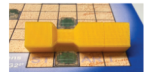
Stephanie can move the crate by tipping it along its edges (in typical rolling block, er, rolling broccoli fashion). She had a special crate constructed in an hourglass shape so that the crate can roll over the frames when on its side. However, Stephanie can't remember how to get the crate out of the garden without crushing her plants. Can you help?



Rules

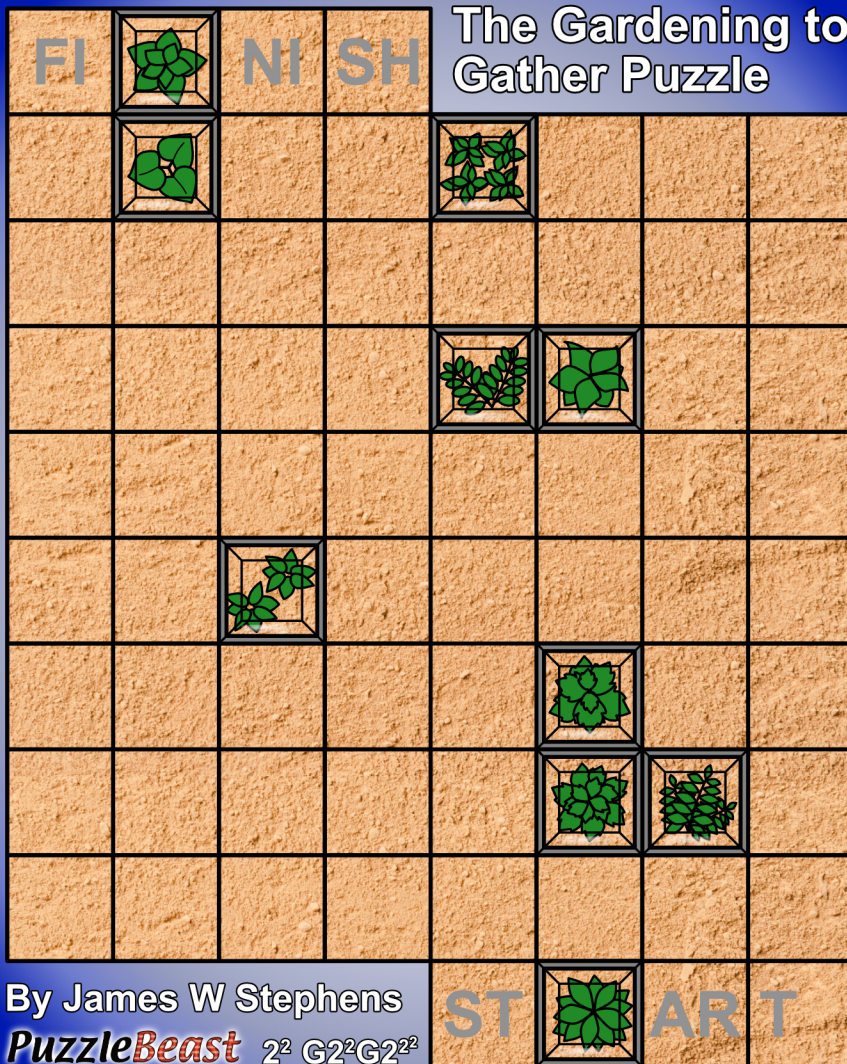
- Start with the crate on its side on the squares marked **START**. (See photo above.)
- Flip to crate along its edges, always staying within the spaces on the board. (See right.)
- Be careful that the crate doesn't come to rest on any of the plants unless they are under the cutout section of the crate.
- Navigate the crate so that it is resting on the squares marked **FINISH**.
- You may use the START or FINISH squares like any of the other squares while solving.
